Duisburg Hauptbahnhof – exit by main entrance

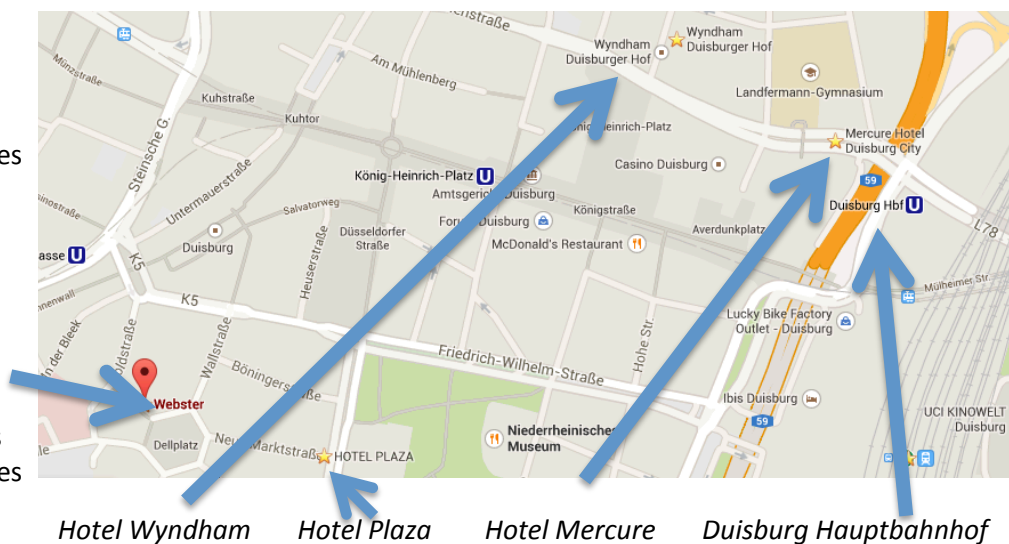
- To Mercure = 5 minutes
